

PRIVACY POLICY

At The Ireland Smart Ageing exchange ("We") are committed to protecting and respecting your privacy.

This policy (together with our terms of use www.isax.ie/policies and any other documents referred to on it) sets out the basis on which any personal data we collect from you, or that you provide to us, will be processed by us. Please read the following carefully to understand our views and practices regarding your personal data and how we will treat it. By visiting www.isax.ie you are accepting and consenting to the practices described in this policy.

For the purpose of the Data Protection Acts 1988 to 2003 (the "Acts"), the data controller is the Ireland Smart Ageing Exchange, 2nd Floor, Arthurs Quay House, Arthurs Quay, Limerick, Ireland, V94 XVRO.

INFORMATION WE MAY COLLECT ABOUT YOU

We may collect and process the following data about you:

- **Information you give us.** You may give us information about you by filling in forms on our site www.isax.ie or by corresponding with us by phone, e-mail or otherwise. This includes information you provide when you register to join The Smart Ageing Community, participate in discussion boards or other social media functions on our site, enter a competition, promotion or survey, and when you report a problem with our site. The information you give us may include your name, address, e-mail address and phone number along with some information relating to your living situation and current health.
- **Information we collect about you.** With regard to each of your visits to our site we may automatically collect the following information:
 - technical information, including the Internet protocol (IP) address used to connect your computer to the Internet, your login information, browser type and version, time zone setting, browser plug-in types and versions, operating system and platform;
 - information about your visit, including the full Uniform Resource Locators (URL) clickstream to, through and from our site (including date and time); properties and hosts you viewed or searched for; page response times, download errors, length of visits to certain pages, page interaction information (such as scrolling, clicks, and mouse-overs), and methods used to browse away from the page and any phone number used to call our customer service number.
- **Information we receive from other sources.** We may receive information about you if you use any of the other services we provide. In this case we will have informed you when we collected that data that it may be shared internally and combined with data collected on this site. We are also working closely with third parties (including, for example, business partners, advertising networks, analytics providers, search information providers) and may receive information about you from them.

COOKIES

Our website uses cookies to distinguish you from other users of our website. This helps us to provide you with a good experience when you browse our website and also allows us to improve our site.

USES MADE OF THE INFORMATION

We use information held about you in the following ways:

- to verify your identity. It is collected and stored on our database
 - to provide you with information about other goods and services that may be of interest to you
 - to provide you, or permit selected third parties to provide you, with information about goods or services we feel may interest you. If you do not want us to use your data in this way, or to pass your details on to third parties for marketing purposes, please tick the relevant box situated on the form on which we collect your data (the order form **OR** registration form);
 - to notify you about changes to our service; and/or
 - to ensure that content from our site is presented in the most effective manner for you and for your computer.

- **Information we collect about you.** We will use this information:
 - to administer our site and for internal operations, including troubleshooting, data analysis, testing, research, statistical and survey purposes;
 - to improve our site to ensure that content is presented in the most effective manner for you and for your computer;
 - to allow you to participate in interactive features of our service, when you choose to do so;
 - as part of our efforts to keep our site safe and secure;
 - to measure or understand the effectiveness of advertising we serve to you and others, and to deliver relevant advertising to you; and/or
 - to make suggestions and recommendations to you and other users of our site about goods or services that may interest you or them.

- **Information we receive from other sources.** We may combine this information with information you give to us and information we collect about you. We may use this information and the combined information for the purposes set out above (depending on the types of information we receive).

DISCLOSURE OF YOUR INFORMATION

We will not share your information with any other group without your consent. With your consent, we may share your information with selected third parties including:

- Advertisers and advertising networks that require the data to select and serve relevant adverts to you and others. We do not disclose information about identifiable individuals to our advertisers, but we may provide them with aggregate information about our users (for example, we may inform them that 500 men aged over 60 have clicked on their advertisement on any given day). We may also use such aggregate information to help advertisers reach the kind of audience they want to target (for example, women in Dublin 4). We may make use of the personal data we have collected from you to enable us to comply with our advertisers' wishes by displaying their advertisement to that target audience.
- Analytics and search engine providers that assist us in the improvement and optimisation of our site.

We may disclose your personal information to third parties:

- In the event that we sell or buy any business or assets, in which case we will disclose your personal data to the prospective seller or buyer of such business or assets.
- If The Ireland Smart Ageing Exchange or substantially all of its assets are acquired by a third party, in which case personal data held by it about its customers will be one of the transferred assets.
- If we are under a duty to disclose or share your personal data in order to comply with any legal obligation, or in order to enforce or apply our terms of use [www.isax.ie/policies] [or terms and conditions of supply [www.isax.ie/policies]] and other agreements; or to protect the rights, property, or safety of [The Ireland Smart Ageing Exchange], our customers, or others. This includes exchanging information with other companies and organisations for the purposes of fraud protection and credit risk reduction.]

WHERE WE STORE YOUR PERSONAL DATA

The data that we collect from you may be transferred to, and stored at, a destination outside the European Economic Area ("EEA"). It may also be processed by staff operating outside the EEA who work for us or for one of our suppliers. Such staff may be engaged in the provision of support services. By submitting your personal data, you agree to this transfer, storing or processing. We will take all steps reasonably necessary to ensure that your data is treated securely and in accordance with this privacy policy.

Unfortunately, the transmission of information via the internet is not completely secure. Although we will do our best to protect your personal data, we cannot guarantee the security of your data transmitted to our site; any transmission is at your own risk. Once we have received

your information, we will use strict procedures and security features to try to prevent unauthorised access.

YOUR RIGHTS

You have the right to ask us not to process your personal data for marketing purposes. We will usually inform you (before collecting your data) if we intend to use your data for such purposes or if we intend to disclose your information to any third party for such purposes. You can exercise your right to prevent such processing by checking certain boxes on the forms we use to collect your data if it arises.
